Kirsten Schuetz was appointed Chief Human Resources Officer (CHRO) of Siemens Gamesa Renewable Energy as of April 1, 2024. Before that, she was Vice President Human Resources Germany at Siemens Energy from 2021.

She has vast international leadership experience both in generalist HR roles in different industries and countries, as well as in employment law and labor relations. She has supported companies in various situations including restructuring, transformation and growth, with a strong focus on HR transformation, trustful social partnerships, people culture, leadership, as well as talent attraction and development.

In the course of her career, Kirsten has worked in different industries including aviation, IT and the automotive industry.
